

ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

Leyden Credit Union was founded on December 16th 1955 as Leyden Schools Credit Union. Membership was limited to all the teachers, employees and immediate family members of District 212. There were 400 members with assets totaling \$350,000.00.

In 1969 eligibility requirements were expanded to include **all** school districts within Leyden Township. Then in 1974 we included employees of Triton College and in 1988 included all students of all schools.

In August of 1979 the credit union moved to a long time home at 9617 Grand Avenue. Then later in 1985 Leyden underwent some remodeling to utilize two adjoining office spaces in that building.

In October of 1993 we became a community credit union welcoming <u>ALL</u> who live or work in Leyden Township. Shortly after, in February of 1994, our name was changed to Leyden Credit Union to better reflect our ability to serve the Leyden community.

In October of 1999 LCU designed a new logo, which is currently being used. In November 2001 we added the following townships to our charter; Addison, Elk Grove, Lyons, Maine, Proviso and York, enabling more people to join the credit union.

Then in December of 2002 LCU moved to our current building at 2701 N 25th Avenue in Franklin Park, now with 5,600 members and assets totaling \$53.5 million.

This special criff is available on all loans which are in good standing, payments cannot be skipped in consecutive months. Smart Choice/I payment balloon loans, open-end line of credits and Mortgages excluded. All other terms and provisions of the original loan agreement are unchanged and remain in full effect. Interest will continue to accrue during the month you skip your payment. In some cases, based on the size of the bilance, the interest which acrouse may be greater than the amount of your next regular payment. It may take several months to be given to reduce your principal balance. If you make a non-automatic payment, the first payment done after the last day of the month prior to the month that you are going to skip will be skipped. If your loan is paid via payrol deduction or other automatic deductions, the amount normally applied to your loan will be deposited into your share/draft account early payred of the month that you are skipping. If a full payment is transferred from savings/checking at Leyden the payment will not be made. If you have any questions contact the credit union's loan department. Subject to approval.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

As most of our members know. LCU is celebrating 50 years as a Credit Union on December 16th. 2005. There have been many changes in those 50 years from starting in the basement of East Leyden High School to our current two story building on 25th Avenue. Our three longest employed staff (68 years of service between them) got together and passed around some fond memories and advancements. At the time we all came on as staff, savings accounts, checking accounts and consumer loans were the only products being offered. Large cash deposits were taken to the bank at first and then we began walking to pick up cash for withdrawals. The equivalent to the pony express, we now get cash by armored car. We would take deposits, give withdrawals

and open savings and checking accounts at the teller window. After moving to our long time home on Grand Avenue, we remodeled and added some offices for privacy when opening an account or taking an appointment for a loan. In the mid-80s we added credit cards to our products and finally purchased an in house data system for faster more efficient service. We also added a 24 hour phone system giving members access to their accounts when they wanted, day or night. In the mid-90s we added Debit Cards to our growing variety of products which helped in offering more to our increasing member base. We also expanded to a Community Charter servicing all who live or work in the following seven townships; Addison, Elk Grove, Maine, Proviso, Leyden,

Lyons and York. In the late 90s we added our website and home banking we also installed the walk up ATM machine and soon grew to add another ATM out on the campus at Triton College in 2001. We've come a long way, baby! Now with the new building on 25th and Grand Avenue built in 2002, we offer a full range of accounts, loans, products and services. Almost too many to list in this letter to you. LCU was guided to stay current with the times and offer the best in products and services to our membership. We are proud to have contributed to a part of LCU's growth. LCU currently has a total of 23 employees with a combined total of 145.5 years on staff.


We will be giving away birthday balloons the week of the 12th through the 16th and on the 16th (our anniversary date) we will be handing out cupcakes.
